



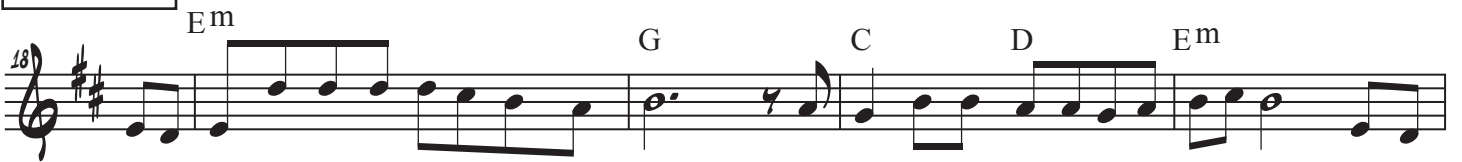


He has looked up-on his hand-maid in her low-li-ness; and all the na-tions forth will call me bless-ed. He has
